

Pantoufle's Wine List

Red

La Puerta Clasico: 2021 Malbec. On the nose, plum and cherries, with a touch of violets. The palate is blackberry fruit and a hint of coffee and a finish of spice. Medium body. Argentine \$9/25

Messer del Fuano D'Avola: 2021 Red Blend. Aromas of licorice, blackberries, and blueberries. Deep ruby in color, blackberry, blueberry, and a hint of coffee and licorice, with sweet tannins and plum and peppery finish. Medium body. Sicilian \$10/22

Root: 1: 2022 Pinot Noir. A very subtle wine from the coastal Casablanca region. Hints of cherry, strawberry, and blackberry for the nose. The palate is bright and smooth with black fruits and red plum, and cherry. Medium body. Casablanca Valley, Chile. \$10/25

90+ Cellars: 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon. On the nose, cassis, black current, and cherry, with a subtle tobacco and oak. The palate is lovely blackberries, black current, and blueberries; finishing with a little spice and dark plum. Mendoza, Argentina. \$10/25

90+ Cellars: 2022 Merlot. This wine is a medium bodied with a ruby hue. Raspberries, pomegranate, and red cherries with hints of herbaceous notes. California \$10/25

Chateau Peyrat: 2020 Red Blend. Grand Vin De Bordeaux. Ruby Red Color. Spicy nose, smashed blackcurrant. On the palate, a pleasant freshness, spicy, nutmeg, and fresh red fruits. Estate bottled, Bordeaux. \$11/29

Joseph Drouhin: 2021 Beaujolais. Gamay from Beaujolais and Burgundy. A blending of wines from various terroirs. It has a vibrant raspberry color and lovely hue. The nose is refined with notes of violet, peony and red fruit jam. Drinking feels silky and fresh, the raspberry and blackberry remain and linger on the palate. France. \$33

Chateau de Lavernette: 2020 Leynes Le Clos Beaujolais. A hint of violet and black fruit on the nose. The wine offers smashed fresh black fruit and a lovely spice on the palate. France. \$39

Postmark: 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon. A nose of raspberry, blueberry, and caramel, with a touch of sage. On the palate are notes of raspberry and blueberry combine with black current and cocoa powder. Medium body. Paso Robles \$15/41

Chateau Laplagnotte-Belleviue: 2020 Red Blend, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru. Aromas of black current, licorice, black cherry, and a touch of graphite. Well-structured silky tannins with a taste of fungus, current, and oyster sauce with black cherry. Bordeaux. \$47

The Prisoner: 2022 Red Blend. Lively aromas of raspberry, vanilla and a wisp of coconut. Flavors of dried blackberry, pomegranate, espresso, and spice. Full body. Napa Valley \$70

Chateau Rauzan Segla: 2015. Red Blend. Deep aromas of blueberry, blackberry, vanilla and a hint of flint. On the tongue a bit of spice followed with black current, blackberry, and a touch of violet, mineral rich. Margaux and Bordeaux \$106

Boroli Villero 2019 Borolo. Dark fruit mixed with baking spices, dried herbs and tobacco. The palate gives robust red and black fruits, with a bit of oak and subtle tannins that combine for an exquisite savory finish. Estate Bottled Italy. \$105

Whites

Tormaresca: 2022 Chardonnay: Floral and lemony notes on the nose. Light and citrusy with hints of white stone fruit and lemon. Puglia, Italy. \$10/25

Axel Des Vignes: 100% Sauvignon blanc from the Bordeaux region. Fresh fruits and citrus flavors. Drinks light and crisp with notes of crisp lemon, and a background of white jasmine and soft minerality. Bordeaux, France. \$11/28

Georg Albrecht Schneider: 2021 Niersteiner Hipping Riesling Spatlese. Fruits in abundance, peaches, apple, and tropical fruit, and a sense of ripeness. Medium sweet. Germany. \$11/26

Louis Moreau: 2022 Petit Chablis 100% Chardonnay. The aromatic nature of this wine is fresh with notes of apples and citrus. Its bright acidity and citrus flavor bring out a roundness on the palate. France \$14/35

Rose

Villa Maria Rose: 2020 This Rose has a lovely salmon pink color and displays bright floral aromas with flavors of strawberry, red fruits and spice, leading to a generous mouthfeel with a deliciously off dry finish. New Zealand. \$10/25

Sparkling

Mat Prosecco: 2020 A lovely dry Italian Prosecco, which presents as dry and crisp on the nose as well as the palate. Italy \$9/25

St. Kilda Brut Cuvee: 2021 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir that is bright and sparkling after a secondary fermentation. A dry and sparkling play on a sparkling cuvee. Australia \$7/28

Minage de Tios: 2020 Prosecco. Dry and vibrant on the nose offering a floral fragrance and lively green apple citrus blend bring the wine a frothy, bubbly finish that shines throughout the evening. Italy \$11/25

Dom Perignon: 2013 The creation of the 2013 vintage reveals the resonance between the pinots noirs and chardonnays, between acidity and full bodied. The precise, elegant and tactile bouquet blooms in an extremely delicate powdery aromatic braid around three nuances: first citrus, then a more vegetal facet and lastly, spices. \$289

Local

Villa Appalaccia Lirico: Vidal Blanc that is cool fermented ensuring crisp, bright flavors. With subtle notes of pineapple, this wine pairs well with seafood, cheese dishes and white sauce pastas. \$9/19

Villa Appalaccia Sangiovese: The wine has a characteristic flavor of strawberries from the Sangiovese and blackberries from the Montepulciano. The wine has a spicy finish of a Chianti-style wine and is recommended to be enjoyed with pasta and grilled meats. \$9/29

Villa Appalaccia Rosa: Made from merlot and semillon grapes. A nice, light body and flavor that will pair well with seafood, salads, burgers, and creamy pastas. \$9/21
